## What is Herald?

- Mail store
- Web-based email & account management

---

## IMAP servers

- Per-user file store
  - IMAP, POP, SMTP to public
  - NFS export to cluster nodes

---

## WING servers

- Web-based email and account management
  - HTTP, SMTP to public
  - IMAP and NFS to IMAP servers
  - SQL to frontends

---

## Frontends

- Only connection to outside world
- Firewall for cluster
- SQL database server
- Hold centralized information
- Name servers for `herald.ox.ac.uk` domain
- Provide SMTP relay for dumb clients (`smtp.ox.ac.uk`)

---

## Facts and Figures

- Currently 10,000 users
- Designed to handle 30,000 users
- 270GB RAID-protected file storage
- Additional 432GB ready to be configured

---

## More Facts and Figures

- On a typical day (during term), a busy IMAP server handled
  - 17500 incoming messages
  - 23500 deliveries and 1100 forwards
  - 65000 IMAP sessions (including 7500 WING sessions)
  - 22000 POP sessions
- A WING server (one of three currently in service) handled
  - 5000 outgoing messages (of which 2000 were destined for Herald)
  - More than 200 concurrent users at peak times

---

## Changes Over the Past Year

- Hardware changes
- Some performance tuning and bug fixes
- Automated backups
- Automated notification of password expiry
- Automated notification when over quota
- Improvements to user administration interface
- Flexible quota system

---

## Future Enhancements

- Mail filters
- Configurable style-sheets
- Searching mailboxes
- Tidying mailboxes
- IMAP command-line

---
