What is WebLearn?

- Integrated set of tools for teaching, learning ,collaboration and research.
- Tools (discussion forum, assessment submission, tests/quiz, content)
- Inside one framework (shared users, authorization, events, content)
- Integrate together well with similar design.



Current Service

- Based on Bodington source
- Physical metaphor
- Content is in a tree
- Dwindling community
- Fewer development resources locally



WebLearn Beta

- http://beta.weblearn.ox.ac.uk/
- Based on the Sakai source
- Main concept is a site
- Large community
- Currently in pilot



What's Better

- Cleaner interface
- Better usability and accessibility
- Simpler access control
- Community Documentation
- More tools
- Good integration
- Good search



Transition Timescales

- Pilot program starts in earnest now
- During next year new features introduced
- Full production service starts Jun 2009
- 2011 current Bodington service becomes read only



New Local Features

- Hierarchy of Sites
- Nice URLs
- Devolved Admin
- Control of Public Access
- Tools to support migration
- Integration with Oxford groups.



Migration Support

- Lots of content can timeout
- Export/Import of content
- Migration of assessments
- Reuse of groups
- Redirects for existing content

What's coming?

- Sakai 3.0
 - Lots of client side development (AJAX)
