What is happening?

- Old WebLearn ('Bodington') is being phased out
- New WebLearn service launched 30 June 2009
- Dual service: old & new systems in parallel
- Old system becomes read-only Sept 2011
- Old system to be withdrawn June 2012
- You (yes you) must migrate your material

New WebLearn


WebLearn is the University's VLE. It has Tools for supporting T&L:





What can it do?

- public or private questionnaire templates
- survey elements
 - Likert scales
 - multiple choice
 - multiple response
 - text boxes
 - headings / free text
- total anonymity (always)
- automatic / manual sending of reminders
- open / close dates
- PDF summary report
- CSV export to Excel



 - Member (Lecturers / Administration staff)


•Create sites where maintainer


- Audit (Internal / External auditors)

- Admin Sites have dedicated tool: Site List






Admin Sites Managing Project Sites
