### **ICT Central Coordination Project (ICCP)**

The project to merge OUCS, BSP and ICTST has completed its first phase, defining the functional groupings required for the new IT department. ### **Nexus Exchange 2010 upgrade**

The Nexus email service is in the process of being upgraded to Microsoft Exchange 2010 during Hilary Term. Main Upgrades start 5 March. Should be finished (bar stragglers) 30 March. We would like to thank all the local IT Staff for their support in this.

### **Rate Limiting**

Due to the need to guard against excessive adverse effects of spam mailings over the vacation, OUCS introduced some rate limiting processes. This has proved very successful and we now will be keeping these in place (with a slight relaxation). We urge anyone who wishes to do large scale mailings, as always, to use the OUCS maillist facility.

### **Email & Phishing**

As everyone is all too well aware we have had a number of problems caused by phished accounts leading to University email being blocked by Hotmail in particular. Given the very low number of users actually phished we are clearly winning the 'education war'. So (a) thank you to all IT staff for doing such a good job & (b) please keep on with your excellent work.

### **Enhanced Authentication Project**

The Enhanced Authentication Project, working in collaboration with Student Administration, has integrated an additional authentication factor (or 'additional verification') with the single sign-on service provided by OUCS (currently using a one-time code sent via SMS). The project is currently being piloted by five departments for use with WebLearn. ### **Research Skills Toolkit**

The Research Skills Toolkit combines workshops and online resource to support students (and staff) in using online tools to support all parts of the research process. The Toolkit has been developed by OUCS in partnership with Bodleian Libraries, Careers Service and academic divisions or faculties. ### **New WebLearn Guidance Site**

2012 sees the introduction of a brand new look for the WebLearn Guidance Site. <https://weblearn.ox.ac.uk/portal/hierarchy/info> We have tried to make the site easier to navigate and also make it look more visually appealing. It should be easier to find what you are looking for as the front page contains links to all sections laid out in a clear and concise manner.

### **Energy Efficiency and Monitoring Service**

The new Energy Efficiency and Monitoring service is currently being piloted with a number of colleges or departments in the University, The service offers the ability to switch on a computer remotely (“wake-on-LAN”) and power management monitoring. ### **Backbone Refresh**

We have to upgrade all the chassis for all the backbone routers as Cisco will not support the equipment housed in the chassis's after October 2012. Each chassis replacement will take 2-3 hours. While the upgrade of the B-routers should not affect users, the upgrade of the C-routers will affect everyone connected to that C-router in particular. Essentially it means that the buildings' connection to the Backbone will be down for the duration of the work, along with any annexe connections which route back through the affected building. We are currently planning to do this work in the Easter and Summer vacations, with consultation, to minimise the impact of this work.

### **Core User Directory Affiliations Manager**

The Core User Directory (CUD) implementation project has developed an Affiliations Manager for capturing and making available to registered users information about people affiliated to colleges or departments that otherwise would not be available via, for example, the HR or student systems. ### **VIDaaS Online Research Database Service and Damaro**

The Virtual Infrastructure with Database as a Service (VIDaaS) project, funded by JISC, ends on 31 March 2012. A parallel activity is scoping the implementation of an

The Data Management Rollout at Oxford (DaMaRO) Project is a follow-on project from VIDaas which is further developing a research data management policy for the University and the infrastructure to enable researchers to comply with it (including integration between the Bodleian Libraries' DataFinder service, the OUCS Online Research Database service, and the Oxford University Research Archive (ORA).
