

# Humanities HT16 Report for ICTF Termly Meeting

The new Humanities IT Forum (formerly Humanities IT Committee) met for the first time this term. There were no presentations, but the topics of \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ were discussed.

Humanities Division, along with four of its faculties are currently working with the Web Platform Team at IT Services developing a shared Drupal platform service to provide the stakeholders with unit websites along with templates for research groups. We hope the production platform will be available for site building during May 2016.

The meeting discussed, amongst other topics, areas in which research IT investment might be used in all phases of the research lifecycle – including grant applications and long-term curation of data and outputs, as well as the research itself – and how it could focus on needs that are likely to be common to multiple research groups, departments or divisions (e.g. website creation and maintenance).
