Student Systems Programme



- Replacing Oracle Student System (OSS) with SITS: Vision and eVision (web access)
- Supporting all major stages in student lifecycle, from preapplication to graduation
- Improving data-sharing with other key systems that support activities associated with Alumni and Development, Finance and Personnel



When?

- November 2012: eVision college degree ceremonies administration and student ceremony bookings live
- October 2013: New ADSS (Admissions Decision Support System) service live
- Summer 2013: Original planned go-live of Phase 1: eVision for management of main student record and admissions, with reporting and data interfaces (e.g. Student Data Feed)



When?

- Comprehensive review resulted in re-planning of timescales for Phase 1:
 - delivery of on-course student record in summer 2014
 - delivery of admissions for 2015-16 cycle
- January 2014: Gateway decision ('Gateway 1')





Risks & mitigation

- Underpinning data model within SITS: Vision
- Migration of data from OSS to SITS: Vision
- Devoting all available resource to mitigate this in time for Gateway 1
- Replacing existing functionality; not enhancing it: 'must haves' as opposed to 'nice to haves'

February - June	Full on-course student record system testing
June - July	User Acceptance Testing
July - October	eVision Training
from August	eVision student record roll-out
	Re-commence admissions development for delivery in 2015




SITS data integration


Dedicated team assigned to:

- Provide support to owners of 'target' systems










