There has been continued activity relating to the finances. We received approval from BSC for our plans to reduce net expenditure by 10% and unless there are any further cuts, we do not think this will impact on services. We are also in lengthy (but preliminary) discussions with the colleges concerning a possible contribution from them re OUCS's costs.

The Nexus project completed and the Sharepoint early adopters programme is now underway. We are also assisting IMSU and UAS re their migration to Nexus (from Groupwise and Lotus Notes respectively).
