# **ICT Central Coordination Project (ICCP)**

The project to merge OUCS, BSP and ICTST has completed its first phase, considering the functions of the new IT department. The new department will be called IT Services and Phase 2 of the project is now underway. Staff have been briefed about the change process and given an overview of the top level structure of the new department. BSP, OUCS and ICTST will all cease to "trade" as their current forms on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2012 and will all be referred to as "IT Services". There will be a new website as an umbrella for all activities and a full website for the new department in the next 6-12 months.

Interactions with IT Services for ITSS will initially be the same as they are now and the 1<sup>st</sup> August will see a very soft launch. The process of merge and integration will take many months and changes that ITSS need to be aware of will be planned and announced in plenty of time. 1<sup>st</sup> August should be seen as the start of the changes, not the end.

### **Energy Efficiency and Monitoring Service**

The new Energy Efficiency and Monitoring service is currently being piloted with a number of colleges or departments in the University, The service offers the ability to

#### **Backbone Chassis refresh**

The chassis of our backbone routers, which have recently celebrated their 10th birthday, are shortly being withdrawn from support by Cisco. As these are a key part of the University network, we need to get these replaced before their EOL date at the end of this year. Unfortunately this process will necessitate a period of downtime to every connected network, so we are planning to perform this work over the summer vacation 2012, during the scheduled Tuesday morning maintenance windows, commencing at 0700. We envisage that each router and its associated connections will be down for up to 4 hours on the allocated day.
